

## Seton Hays Hosts Community Health Fair

The success of the second annual Seton Medical Center Hays Community Health Fair on Oct. 22 can be measured in the following numbers:



- More than 650 participants

- Seton Diabetes Education provided more than 100 glucose screenings
- Hard Hats for Little Heads fit 90 children with new helmets
- Twenty women signed up for express mammograms at the hospital
- Seton Hays Food Services provided cooking demonstrations to more than 200 people
- Walgreens gave 35 flu shots and gave away 500 pill boxes
- Sam's Club tested the vision of more than 200 participants
- Seton Hays Mother/Baby program distributed more than 300 car tags
