OB/GYN Delineated Privileging Form Revisions Approved

A message from the Joint Chiefs of the Obstetrics & Gynecology Specialty Service

The revised/updated delineated privileging form has been approved by the OB/GYN physicians, Network Credentials Committee and Network MEC.

Effective immediately, the new delineation forms will be mailed to new physician(s) and physician(s) up for April 2012 reappointment.

Key Revisions

- New applicants: the physician must provide documentation of completion of the Ascension Health Online Maintenance Program in Electronic Fetal Monitoring Course or evidence of attendance at a EFM course approved by the Specialty Service Chief in advance, AND participation at one Seton Perinatal Teamwork Simulation Training session within their provisional year.
- At the time of reappointment: the physician must provide documentation of completion of the Ascension Health Online Maintenance Program in Electronic Fetal Monitoring Course or evidence of attendance at a EFM course approved by the Specialty Service Chief in advance, AND participation at one Seton Perinatal Teamwork Simulation Training session within the previous 24 months.
- Robotic-Assisted Surgery (RAS): applicants must complete the separate RAS Delineation Form. To request the form, please call (512) 324-3570.
