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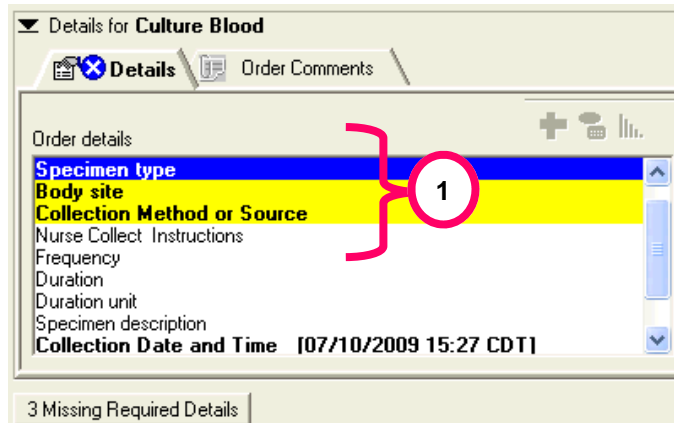
### Information for All Physicians

#### New Orders

- **Carnitine Total** lab order. May also be found by entering **CARTOT** in order search window.
- **NM SPCT Lexiscan** radiology order. May also be found by entering **NMSPCTLEXI** in order search window.

#### Changes to Existing Orders

- While discharge hygiene is a standard instruction given to patients, the specific instructions had to be free texted into an existing Discharge Instructions order within COMPASS' powerplans for each patient. To save clinicians this extra work, a new **Discharge Hygiene** order has been added to all powerplans with discharge instructions.
- The following changes were made to the *MRI Extremities with Contrast* careset:
  - Order details are now divided into two groups: "IV Contrast with Sedation" and "IV Contrast w/o Sedation". The with Sedation orders appear at the top of the list.
  - Once you select your desired order detail, the system will automatically answer any sedation-related questions within the order. You no longer have to fill out these fields.
- **Carnitine Esterfied** and **Carnitine Ester/Free Ratio** results are now included in the *Carnitine Total, Free* (or CARNTF) lab order.
- For Micro orders, the required fields now appear at the top of the order detail window (1).



## Information for All Physicians

### Changes to Existing Orders (cont.)

- The Haptoglobin Lab result will now post under **Chemistry** – not Immunology/Serology – on the Flowsheet.

### Changes to Existing Orders

- Additional Rad orders were added to these pedi powerplans:
  - ED Abdominal Pain Pediatric* powerplan:
    - CT Abd/Pelvis w/ Contrast
    - CT Abd/Pelvis w/o Contrast
  - ED Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea/Dehydration Pediatric* powerplan:
    - XR Chest 1 View
    - XR Abdomen Flat/Upright
    - XR Abdomen AP

## Information for Emergency Dept. Physicians

### Documentation

- In ExitCare, the date options in the *Follow Up* field have changed. Previously, when physicians select a “Who” or quick-pick (1), the follow-up date would default to “in 1 week” and automatically calculate a **specific date**. Some patients were confused and thought this meant the appointment had already been set up on their behalf. Now, only a date range will appear (2). Physicians may still chose to select and show a specific date by using the calendar box at right (3) instead of the options in the drop-down box.
