  - Diagnostic Follow-up
  - Sample to be rerun
  - Exceeds Reportable Range
  - Notified To

## Information for All Physicians

### New Plans

- A new *Anti Coagulation Heparin Infusion Protocol Adult* powerplan has replaced the previous *Anti Coagulation Protocol* in COMPASS. The new plan mirrors the Network Heparin Infusion Protocol Adult on the Seton Intranet.
- A new *Anti Coagulation Heparin Infusion Protocol for Cardioembolic Stroke* powerplan has been added to COMPASS. This plan mirrors the Network Heparin Infusion for Cardioembolic Stroke on the Seton Intranet.

### Changes to Existing Lab Orders

- Protein Electrophoresis, Serum (BRC) replaced with *Protein Electrophoresis*
- Protein Electrophoresis, Urine (BRC) replaced by Protein Electrophoresis Urine
- ANA Screen replaced with *Anti Nuclear Antibodies with Reflx Titer*
- Urine Immunofixation replaced by *Immuno electrophoresis Urine*
- In the *Cell Count with Diff Joint Fluid* order, Synovial Fluid was added as a joint fluid option.
- For SMCH only, the Urine Drug Screen order has been re-named Drug Tox Urine Screen. It may also be found by entering Urine Drug Tox Screen.

### Lab orders no longer available in COMPASS

- PTH Intact

### Changes to Blood Bank Orders

- In the *Blood Bank Product* field, the Packed RBC option is now a Yes/No field.

## Information for Hospitalists

### Changes to Existing Orders

- Within the "Hospitalist Orders Admit" powerplan, Creatine Kinase (CK) collection priority was changed from AM to Routine.  
An "including any ED draws" option was added to the Troponin and Creatine Kinase (CK) orders.

## Information for Emergency Physicians

### Misc.

- Improvements were made in FirstNet so the Checkout tab so load more quickly at SMCW. This was not a problem at SMCH.

## Information for Surgeons

### New Orders/Plans

- A *PACU PostOp Orders Cardiovascular Surgery* powerplan for use at SMCW only.
- A *VATS/Thoracic Surgery* powerplan for both SMCH and SMCW.
- The *Anti-Coagulation Heparin Infusion Protocol Adult* was added to the powerplans listed below.
  - Acute Coronary Syndrome, Unstable Angina
  - Admit to Medicine Adult
  - Chest Pain Admit
  - Standard Admission Orders Adult

  - ICU Gen Admission
  - Chest Pain ACS Unstable Angina Admission Orders
  - Cardiac Post Interventional Proc Adm
