## Tips and Tricks June 2008

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### Information for Critical Care Physicians

#### SMCW-Specific

- Critical Care clinicians at SMCW received a patient Tracking Board in late May. This extra-large monitor is mounted on the wall opposite on nursing station. The Tracking Board will allow clinicians a quick review of patient status and resulted lab/rad, etc. Please note the Tracking Board is view-only. A user cannot interface with the Tracking Board. In early June, critical care physicians, RN managers, adult RNs and CA IIIs will receive a new view in COMPASS, called the Tracking List, which mirrors the content of the Tracking Board. This list will provide a shortcut to review lab/rads on the flowsheets and allergies.

# Information for Emergency Department Physicians

## All Facilities

- At the request of EDJPC, the existing Up-to-Date hyperlink in COMPASS was replaced with a hyperlink to the Emergency Medicine home page on the Seton Intranet. This page contains a wealth of information including:
  - Department guidelines
  - Procedure Notes
  - Standing orders
  - Directory of ED Medical Directors
  - Useful Links (see illustration at right)
- When "Equipment by Bedside" is ordered, a new event will start and this icon  will be visible on the Tracking List for all positions.
- When the Triage form is completed, a new EP Assess icon  will appear in the EP column. This icon is an alert that the patient is ready to be seen. When a provider is assigned, the icon will disappear. This process was also piloted by SMCW's ED.
- After a successful pilot at SMCW, an EP column is now be the first column on the Emergency Physician's Tracking List. The sort order for the physician's Tracking List is now:
  - EP = Assigned Physician (Column with initials)
  - ESI = Acuity from Triage form
  - LOS = Length of Stay

## Information for All Physicians Regardless of Department

### All Facilities

- Results for RBC Morph and Platelet Estimates now appear in full on the Flowsheet. Users no longer have to click open the *Results Window* to view complete results.
- Rehab treatment orders were re-named for easier location:

Old Name	New Name
PT Addl Tx	PT Treatment Update
OT Addl Tx	OT Treatment Update
ST Addl Tx	ST Treatment Update

- The *Med Rec on Admission Rpt* now correctly displays Last Dose dt/tm (for sites using electronic med reconciliation)

### SMCW-Specific

- Two new orders available:
  - Protocol RC: Non-invasive Pos Press Vent
  - Protocol RC: BiPAP CPAP Protocol
- Anticoagulation protocols will be re-named so they are easier to locate. New names are:
  - DVT Anticoagulation Protocol
  - DVT/PE/ACS Heparin/Coumadin Therapy Protocol Adult
  - DVT Prophylaxis Protocol
  - DVT Heparin for Cardioembolic Stroke Only Protocol
